## **Who is a Mission Continues Fellow?**

A Mission Continues Fellow is a wounded or disabled post-9/11 veteran who has accepted the challenge to continue his/her service to our country by serving in his/her community.

## **What is a Mission Continues fellowship?**

A fellowship is an opportunity for a Fellow to utilize his/her military skills and leadership in a civilian setting. Fellowships are 14-28 weeks in length, during which the Fellow volunteers at a local charitable organization, providing a tangible service to the community.

All Mission Continues fellowships are served in honor of a fallen service member through our *Families of the Fallen* program.

## **What are the benefits of a fellowship?**

If a Fellow is in need of financial assistance, The Mission Continues may provide stipends of up to \$6,000 to offset cost-of-living expenses. A fellowship also provides the Fellow with the opportunity for professional development, networking and career-building experiences.

In addition, Fellows report that their volunteerism has given them a sense of purpose and contribution to those in need.

## **Who is eligible for a fellowship?**

This is a competitive program and in order to be eligible, a potential Fellow must meet these requirements:

- Post 9/11 service
- Honorable discharge
- Disability rating with VA
- Desire to help those in need
